CLUB SECRETARY REPORT

REPEATER – 2M is working OK, possible heat related, intermittent, receiver sensitivity issue is being investigated. 6M is off the air. 1.25M is working OK. DMR is working OK.

NET - Richard, KE0QYA reported that all July net controls have been filled and all will be conducted by women operators in the club. Paul, KD0ETL reported the 75M Sunday net, simplex net, and 220 nets are all active. Dennis, KY0P commented on the rag-chew net started on Tuesday at 7:00pm on the club 2M repeater.

EMA –Richard, KE0QYA gave weather net report, Paul, KD0ETL gave ARES report.

PUBLIC INFORMAION – Dennis, KY0P encouraged promos of our hamfest whenever possible. Richard, KE0QYA gave Face Book/website report, Connie, WA0QCJ gave newsletter status report.

WRECKING CREW – Steve, WA0WUY is looking to do antenna work. Mark, N0OWZ looking for September tower work. Dennis, KY0P needs coax replaced.

OLD BUSINESS –

SCOTT JOPLIN report – Trailer dispatched 6/4/22 to downtown Sedalia in support of special event station W0R and the Scott Joplin festival. There was a positive public showing. Over 100 contacts made. Certificates were presented to workers. Custom collectable QSL cards will be sent to contacts.

FIELD DAY report – The 'FD committee' reported on the event. All went well, everyone had a good time despite the 107+ heat index. Thanks to Steve, KC8AEK for taking care of log processing. 35 attendees, 1,520

points submitted. The club was 5A MO class. The trailer was dispatched for this June 25 event. Richard, KE0QYA suggested a future FD might have members initially operate from home stations and begin club activities later during cooler parts of the day. Perhaps set up and operating Sunday morning from 8a to 1p.

TABLE COVER – The new table cover was received and displayed to the club. It is professional quality, white on black depicting the club logo and name. It covers the top of an 8' table, drapes down the front, and has printed side panels so the club will be advertised from all angles. The club members approved the expense for this item at a previous meeting.

SPARKFEST – October 15 event. Richard, KE0QYA reported that last year we had 52 tables + vendors and there was a good return. The current table reservations are currently at 53 confirmed with several new vendors committing and +20 to +25 additional potential. Work is being done to increase the available number of tables by around 30. If growth continues, then the club may need to investigate alternative venues. Brad, KF0GSX kindly offered the extra tables that are going to be required for this year. Connie, WA0QCJ displayed two large SparkFest banners donated to the club by her friend Shane. These banners are heavy duty, black on yellow, and professionally made. Thank-you cards were signed by those at the meeting and will be sent to Shane. Bret, W0VK said the event will be conducted similar to last year. Scott, KJ4MFW is reaching out for prizes.

Trailer Electrical – The trailer is scheduled to be delivered to Mark, K0NYE who will professionally go thru wiring to not only address an on going electrical issue, but to assure safety.

Warrensburg hamfest is next Saturday. The club will have a table and will be the first public display for the new table cover. Volunteers were recruited to staff the table.
