WHO'ZIT







Sedalia Cadet Flight – (Unit NCR-MO-009)



Kansas Ham Issued \$10,000 Fine
On December 5, Glen Rubash, KC0GPV, of Dwight,
Kansas, was issued a \$10,000 fine for what the FCC
called "willfully and repeatedly" violating Section 301
of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended by
operating an unlicensed radio transmitter on the
frequency 88.3 MHz in Manhattan, Kansas. (...and you
thought the cost of <u>buying</u> radios was expensive!)
